US 29 Pedestrian Bridge to be reopened for the month of October

ELLICOTT CITY, MD – The Howard County Department of Public Works has been informed that a contractor's difficulty in securing materials needed to manufacture the new spiraling geometric cage for the US 29 Pedestrian Bridge has led to a delay in the completion of the project. Because of that supply delay, the bridge will be re-opened in the morning on September 27 and will remain open daily from dawn until dusk until construction resumes.

The County will continue to distribute and honor bus passes for those travelling between the Oakland Mills Village Center and the Mall in Columbia, during the time the bridge is re-opened.

The bridge will be closed again in early November and the project is now slated to be completed in early January.
