## A) Repair of Cable Boxes and/or Phone Boxes

- 2) Call Verizon at 888-553-1555 or call Comcast at 888-739-1379. Be specific about the location of the cable box/phone box problem **or**
- 3) Send an email to the Howard County Cable Administration Office at cadmin@howardcountymd.gov

## B) Roads / Sidewalks / Storm drains / Street trees

- 1) **To report a non-emergency highway maintenance concern** such as road condition, sidewalks, storm drainage or street tree issue, contact the Bureau of Highways at 410-313-7450, via the <u>Tell HoCo</u> website or by email at <a href="highways@howardcountymd.gov">highways@howardcountymd.gov</a>. Or use the <u>SeeClickFix.com</u> website or SmartPhone app.
- 2) For urgent/emergency situations <u>use your best judgement</u> and either call 911 or (flooding, a stop sign down, a fallen tree blocking the road, etc.), or please call 410-313-7450, so that Howard County Bureau of Highways may immediately respond to your emergency request.
